SCOTTISH DANCE TEACHERS` ALLIANCE FESTIVAL RULES

- SDTA Festival is open to dancers deemed as amateur. An amateur is someone who does not receive renumeration other than out of pocket expenses within the dance profession. Full time or vocational students are ineligible.
- Entry all entries MUST be submitted on official entry forms and received by the organiser no later than 18.00 on the closing date. Late entries WILL NOT BE
- Entries will not be accepted without appropriate fees.
- A novice competitor will move to Open with a mark of 83 or above.
- NO POINTE WORK IN BEGINNERS OR NOVICE SECTIONS.
- A competitor may only make a single entry in any solo section.
- In Solo Character ,National and Greek sections the title of the dance must be given to the announcer prior to the competition. No Scottish OR IRISH National allowed
- A BEGINNER is a competitor who has never competed in a stage dance festival and may only dance in one festival as a beginner.
- A NOVICE is a competitor over the age of 6 years who has not been awarded a sufficient mark or place to qualify for entry into open section. Competitors should check with their teacher if unsure as different festivals now have different rules.
- Beginners and Novice section are confined to competitor's resident in Scotland. Babies, Open sections, and Championships are open.
- Age of competitor to be taken from 1st day of festival.
- THE TIMETABLE WILL BE PUBLISHED ON THE SDTA FB PAGE AND WEBSITE AFTER ENTRIES ARE CLOSED
- Competitors must be ready to dance in numerical order according to the timetable, with the exception of groups and troupes when the first set ready should prepare to dance.
- The ORGANISERS decision is FINAL regarding any rules not mentioned .
- ONLY IPODS OR PHONES MAY BE USED FOR MUSIC NO C.D.'S
- Teachers are asked to ensure pupil's I Pod`s (PHONES) are ready to play and passwords taken off when they appear on stage.

- IF USING IPOD (PHONE)PLEASE HAVE SEPARATE PLAYLISTS FOR EACH DANCE, PLAYLIST SHOULD HAVE COMPETITORS NAME AND DISCIPLINE, competitors' number should be clearly marked on iPod (phone) please remove any previous competition numbers.
- No re-dance allowed in any Open Sections, except for technical failure of equipment.
- TIME LIMITS ON SONG AND DANCE HAVE BEEN CHANGED TO REFLECT TDCI RULES
- BABIES, BEGINNERS, NOVICE, OPEN A AND OPEN B 2 MINUTES MAX OPEN C,D,E,F, 2MINUTES 30 SECONDS

CHAMPIONSHIP Registration Cards

- All competitors must hold a current TDCI Registration Card.
- It is the sole responsibility of the teacher's to ensure all their competitors register annually. Registration is from 1st January to
- 31st December.

<u>Classes</u>

The Championships are held in the following age groups: Baby 5 & Under - Juvenile (6-9 yrs.) Junior (10-13 yrs.) Senior (14-17 yrs.)

Baby Sections in Championship events

All babies must be registered. Babies may re-dance if a lapse of memory occurs.

<u>Ages</u>

Competitors must be of the stipulated age on the first day of the preceding SDTA Festival.

<u>Pointe Work</u>

Pointe work is not permitted in Juvenile or Junior Championships.

<u>Time Limits</u>

Baby, Juvenile Ballet, Tap, Modern -1 min 30 seconds. Song/Dance /Acro- 2 mins Junior and Senior Ballet, Tap, Modern -2 mins Junior and Senior Song/Dance -Acro - 2 mins 30 seconds.

<u>Music</u>

- Vocal or non-vocal music may be used in all sections except song and dance.
- Own voice only in song and dance
- Miming in song and dance is not permitted.
- A vocal arrangement can be used in the dance element of the routine.
- The dance music must be the first and only recorded item, multiple song lists will not be allowed.

<u>Props</u>

• Due to Health and Safety Regulations no large props are permitted in TDCI Championship events. **Handheld props only.** The competitor or someone of a similar age may carry the prop onto the stage.

Registration

- Competitors must report at the registration desk at least 30 minutes before they are due to dance.
- No allowance can be made for the late arrival of a competitor
- Dancing out of order is not allowed in a Championship

Re-Dance

- A re-dance is not permitted in Championships, technical and equipment failure being the exception.
- Babies 5 and under will be allowed a re-dance if a lapse of memory occurs.

Conditions of Entry

• Competitors must have received training from the entering school for at least nine months solely prior to the date of the Championship.

Photography and recording of competitors by the general public is not permitted.

The SDTA does not accept liability for the infringement of current copyright or performing rights arising from any competitor`s musical arrangement.

Any complaint or objection relating to the Festival and Championships will only be considered by the Organiser at the end of the event.

SAFEGUARDING STATEMENT

SDTA place the safety of children as paramount, and without exception, have the right to protection from abuse. All concerns, disclosures, allegations, and complaints will be taken seriously and responded to swiftly and accordingly. Our aims are to encourage and promote the children's love of dance in a professional and competitive way with qualified adjudicators and organisers.

ADJUDICATORS

- Adjudicators must hold at least one full Fellowship Qualification in either tap, ballet or modern and Membership in the other theatre genres with a recognised dance teaching organisation.
- ADJUDICATORS MUST BE ON OFFICIAL TDCI LIST.
- Theatre professionals or celebrity guests may be invited to join the adjudicating panel .
- An adjudicator may not judge their own pupil, or an ex pupil, who has received tuition at their school within nine months prior to the date of the Championship.
- A minimum of three adjudicators is required to officiate at National and International Championships.

MARKING OF CHAMPIONSHIPS

- Report forms may or may not be issued at the discretion of the organiser.
- Competitors will be marked out of 100 then placed 1-6
- A recall of approximately one third of the entry will be selected and reduced by elimination to either a semi-final or a final, a final is 6 competitors.
- THERE CAN ONLY BE ONE WINNER OF A CHAMPIONSHIP. In the unlikely event of a tie for any place a re-dance must occur.
- Official marking sheets will be supplied by Theatre Dance Council International. They must be checked and signed by the Scrutineer and or Adjudicator and returned to the General Secretary within 10 days of the Championship date.
