Solo Choreography registration will begin at 11:00 a.m. and will not commence prior to 11:30 a.m. Afternoon registration will begin at 12:30 p.m. Premier dancers will not commence prior to 1:00 p.m. and will begin with the Scottish Lilt.

The competition will be conducted in accordance with the rules of the Scottish Official Board of Highland Dancing. Categories are defined by the S.O.B.H.D. Groups will be divided according to entries received. Numbers will be handed out on the day of competition. Any complaint against SDTA (ON) Milton or the adjudication of the event must be in writing, with the complainant's signature accompanied by a fee of \$25.00. Complaints must be lodged with SDTA (ON) Milton within 48 hours of the event for consideration at their next meeting.
